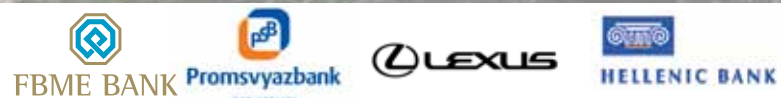

Since its inception in 2000, the **International Pharos Chamber Music Festival** has established itself as the most important annual music event in Cyprus, and has gained an international reputation for its quality concerts and magnificent settings. Guided by a visionary spirit and dedicated to artistic excellence and innovation, the Festival attracts over 2.000 visitors every year. The Festival maintains also a strong tradition of community service, with educational concerts organized for students of primary and secondary education, as well as a number of master-classes for young instrumentalists.

The **12th International Pharos Chamber Music Festival** comprises 10 concerts throughout May-June, in three unique venues in Cyprus: the impressive Royal Manor House in the ancient village of Kouklia, birthplace of the Goddess Aphrodite; the Foundation's venue for intimate events, The Shoe Factory, situated in the run-down part of Nicosia; and The Olive Grove, a world-class, open-air venue surrounded by the idyllic forest of Delikipos.
